Message from the Executive Committee....

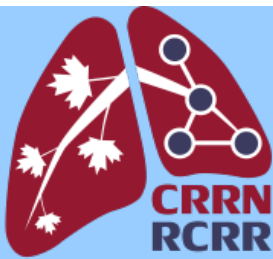


The Executive Committee met via teleconference on

These reports will be very helpful for us to get ready for the CRRN mid-term evaluation with ICRH which is being held in November 2015.

As you all know The CRRN Executive Committee and other CRRN members are busy preparing our SPOR grant application due October 15th, 2015. We are very hopeful that we can achieve the minimum matching funds of \$12,450,000 over five years from our institutions, hospital foundations, and the FRSQ.
